The Health Insurance Marketplace: Changes to Come and What You Need to Know

The Marketplace open enrollment period for enrolling in affordable health coverage begins on November 1, 2016 and ends on January 31, 2017. Starting January 1, 2017, Blue Cross Blue Shield North Carolina will be the only insurer offering coverage through the Marketplace for Cumberland County residents. In past years, Blue Cross Blue Shield was known for having premium rates that often proved to be unaffordable for most consumers. The amount of financial assistance available to consumers is based on the plans offered in their county. So, if the plans available on the Marketplace are more expensive in 2017 than in previous years, financial assistance will increase to cover the difference for those who qualify for financial assistance.

Making the switch to Blue Cross Blue Shield NC means that consumers who are currently enrolled in a Marketplace plans must take action to ensure their coverage remains consistent and active. In order to make this process as easy as possible, consumers are advised to actively re-enroll in a new health plan for 2017. Consumers may choose to do one of the following:

Available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week

Important Dates to Remember:

November 1, 2016: Open Enrollment starts — first day you can enroll, re-enroll, or change a 2017 insurance plan through the Health Insurance Marketplace.

December 15, 2016: Last day to enroll in or change plans for coverage to start January 1, 2017.

January 31, 2017: Last day to enroll in or change a 2017 health plan. After this date, you can enroll or change plans only if you qualify for a Special Enrollment Period.
